Mark J. Agnessi, Sr., 94, of Kingsford passed away on Friday, November 10, 2023, at Evergreen Assisted Living in Kingsford.

Mark was born April 25, 1929, in Iron Mountain, MI, son of the late Romeo and Orlanda (Baldrice) Agnessi. He graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1947 and enlisted in the U.S. Coast Guard where he served for three years and was honorably discharged. Mark attended Michigan State University and earned his Bachelor's Degree in Social Work in 1957. He worked for the State of Michigan for 25 years before retiring in 1984.
