IRON MOUNTAIN - Marshall H. Johnson, 87, of 900 E. "F" St., Iron Mountain, died Friday, Dec. 5, 2008, at the Dickinson County Memorial Hospital.

He was born July 15, 1921, in Iron Mountain, son of the late John and Ebba (Swanson) Johnson.

Marshall graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1940. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and was the recipient of the Purple Heart.
