Marvin G. Fetterly 76, of Kingsford, passed away on Friday, March 28, 2014 at the Oscar G. Johnson V.A. Medical Center in Iron Mountain. He was born on April 22, 1937 in Kingsford, Michigan, son of the late Edward and Ella (Ninneman) Fetterly. He attended the Kingsford schools, graduating from Kingsford High School in 1955. He enlisted in the United States Army in September of 1960, during the Viet Nam War, and was honorably discharged in 1962. Marvin work as a diesel mechanic, truck driver and salesman for Schultz Equipment, retiring after 35 years of service. He was a lifelong resident of Kingsford. He was a faithful member of the Our Redeemer Lutheran Church, and he was a long time member of the Carpenter-Clash American Legion Post #363.
