Mary Anne Jacobson, 80, of Aurora, passed away on Saturday, January 16, 2016 at Maple Ridge Nursing Home in Green Bay, WI.

Mary Anne was born July 1, 1935 in Iron Mountain, MI, daughter of the late Joseph and Mary (Duda) Stankevich. She graduated from Kingsford High School in 1953. She married Richard Jacobson on April 25, 1959 and he preceded her in death in 1979. Mary Anne worked as a realtor for Wildwood Realty for many years.
