



## Mary Lancour

February 2, 1921 - February 2, 2009

IRON MOUNTAIN - Mary A. Lancour, 88, of Escanaba, formerly of Iron Mountain, passed away on Monday, February 2, 2009 at Christian Park Village in Escanaba.

Mary was born May 11, 1920 in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Anton and Mary (Bianchini) Cavaiani. She graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1938 and attended business college where she received a degree in accounting and stenography. She married Clinton Lancour on November 8, 1947 and they enjoyed 53 years of marriage until his death on April 6, 2000. Mary was assistant county clerk, worked for civil service, and was head cashier at Montgomery Wards for several years. She also prepared income tax.
