Mary Ann Nord, 72, of Kingsford, passed away on Monday, June 18, 2012, surrounded by her loving family and comforting dog, after a long, courageous and inspiring struggle with pulmonary fibrosis. She was born on October 23, 1939, in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Andrew and Helen (Kassin) Legault. She graduated from Kingsford High School in 1957. Mary Ann was a lifelong resident of the area, although she enjoyed wintering in Florida and Arizona with her husband, Douglas Nord, whom she married on June 21, 1958, at the American Martyr's Catholic Church in Kingsford. Today would have been the couple's 54th wedding anniversary. She cherished her time at home raising her daughters and spending time with her grandchildren and great grandchildren, as well as helping her husband with their business, Hometowne Lumber in Kingsford. Mary Ann was a member of the Iron Mountain/Kingsford Jaycettes and the Pine Grove Country Club.
