MaryEllen Gallino, 83, of Iron Mountain, passed away peacefully on January 15, 2016, at Evergreen Meadows in Norway, Michigan surrounded by her family. She was born on February 24, 1932 in Menominee Michigan, the daughter of the late Leo and Angie (Rivolta) Godin.

Gallino; and Sheena (Jeff) Haverty; great grandchildren: Callie, Phoebe and Willow; sister Rozanne (John) Carter; sister-in-law, Anne Godin; her dear special cousin, Patti Rosenblum, and many loving nieces and nephews.

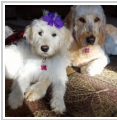
