Matthew D. Neuens, 93 of Aurora, WI went to meet his Savior on January 11, 2020. Matthew, known to many as “Chub” was born on August 28, 1926 to Mathias and Martha (Slater) Neuens. He has been a lifelong resident of Aurora. Matthew married the love of his life, Donna M. LaDuron on August 6, 1949, and recently celebrated 70 years of marriage.

Matt worked as a welder/fabricator for Lakeshore Inc. for 37 years, retiring in 1988. He will always be remembered for his love of the Lord, being ordained into the ministry.
