FOSTER CITY - Melvin Carl "Muvvie" Edberg, 91, of Foster City, passed away peacefully on Thursday, Jan. 14, 2010, at HCR Manorcare in Kingsford where he had resided for the past four months.

He was born on Oct. 25, 1918, in Breen Township, son of the late John and Freida (Swanson) Edberg. He grew up and spent most of his life in the Felch area. He loved the outdoors and enjoyed his years as a woods worker. He often worked side by side with his wife of 27 years, Eva. In his younger days he worked in an ammunition factory in Rockford, Ill., and then worked on the building and construction of the Groveland Mine. After that Muvvie went to work as a logger in the woods until retiring.

He married Eva Murray-Myers on Feb. 7, 1970, at Zion Lutheran Church in Metropolitan, and she preceded him in death on Feb. 19, 1997. He enjoyed fishing, yard work, playing cards, and coffee clutching with friends and family. Melvin was an easy going, soft spoken man and will be missed by all who knew him.

Melvin is survived by a devoted son, Richard (Mary) Edberg of Hardwood; a sister, Vernice Palmer of Joliet, Ill.; a step-son, Gary Myers of Racine, Wis.; a step-daughter, Gail (Steve) Keidl of Rochester, Minn.; 11 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Eva, a son, John Melvin Edberg, three brothers, Ewald, Helmer, and Arnold, two sisters, Ruth and Melba and a great-grandson, Aaron Carl Edberg.
