Michael A. Kuhns, 49, of Iron Mountain, died Tuesday, August 9, 2001 at the Dickinson County Memorial Hospital.

He was born June 9, 1962 in Milwaukee, WI, son of Thomas Kuhns and the late Shirley Luellwitz Kuhns. Mike came to Iron Mountain with his parents and siblings in 1972 and has been a resident here since that time. Growing up, he was very active in sports, especially baseball and basketball.
