Michael P. "Wop" Campbell, 71, of Aurora, died Wed. March 25, 2015 at his home. He was born on June 20, 1943 in Iron Mountain, the son of the late Paul and Margaret (Pardiso) Campbell.

Michael graduated from Kingsford High School in 1962. He worked at Kacker's Gas Station before going to work at Wisconsin Electric, where he worked as a dam operator and a substation electrician.
