FLORENCE, Wis. - Michael G. Frehse, 62, of Patten Lake in Florence, formerly of Loretto, died unexpectedly Tuesday, Nov. 18, 2008, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital, amid a long battle with cancer.

He was born on Dec. 15, 1945, in Norway, to Howard and Lorraine (Anderson) Frehse. Mike graduated from Vulcan High School in 1964 and served in the United States Marines Corps.

He married Rose Rocchietti of Norway on Nov. 7, 1970, in Loretto.

Mike farmed in Loretto and drove truck for Twin City Concrete before he formed Frehse Construction Co., which he owned and operated until his retirement in 1999.

He enjoyed hunting, golfing, traveling, spending time with his grandchildren, and walking his dog, Kodi.

Mike is survived by his wife, Rose; a daughter, Wendy (Tom) of Greenfield, Ind.; three grandchildren, Michaela, Skylar, and Kylie of Greenfield; his mother, Lorraine of Kingsford; his sister, Pat (Dave) Rossi of Kokomo, Ind.; his brother, Bill of Loretto; and many aunts, cousins, nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his father, Howard.
