Miles Joseph Groeneveld, 18, of Iron Mountain, died Saturday, May 29, 2010, at Marquette General Hospital.

He was born on Aug. 9, 1991, in Iron Mountain, the son of Robert and Jean (Agnessi) Groeneveld.

Miles was a very fun loving, charming, and generous young man, who touched the lives of many. He was a very talented artist, and liked skateboarding and biking. Due to his quick thinking ability, Miles was an excellent rapper. Miles was also very fond of his cat, Benny. He was a student at Iron Mountain High School. He was also a member of Immaculate Conception Catholic Church, where he served as an altar server.
