(Matt Heniser) of Missouri and Jennifer Weber of Iron Mountain; her great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.

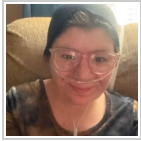
In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by her son, Michael J. Weber.

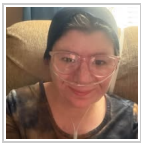

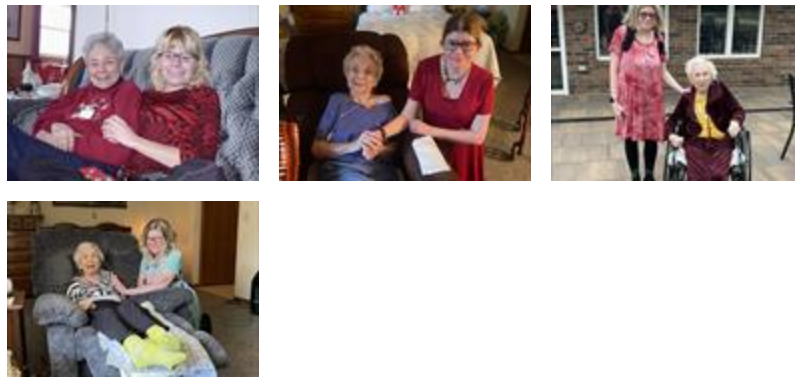
