Myron Donald Fetterly, 91, of Kingsford, passed away Sunday, November 13, 2022, at Maryhill Manor in Niagara, after a short stay.

Myron was born September 24, 1931, in Kingsford, the son of Edward and Ella (Ninneman) Fetterly. He graduated from Kingsford High School, Class of 1949, and in 1954 he married Josephine Kuczala, daughter of Joseph and Mary (Tartar) Kuczala. She preceded Myron in death on Dec. 12, 1998. He served in the U.S. Air Force and worked 29 years with Smeester Brothers. Later in life Myron enjoyed driving for Four Seasons Beer Distributor. Myron was an active member of the American Legion and was a volunteer at the Oscar G. Johnson VA Medical Center. He loved spending time at camp and enjoyed snowmobiling, 4 wheeling, tinkering, splitting wood, and hunting. Myron was an active member of the American Legion Post 363 and was especially proud to wear his father's WWI Army uniform during the Memorial Day Parade in 2018 at the Quinnesec Cemetery.

He is survived by his 2 children, Debra (Mark) Baravetto and Pamela Bullinger; 2 grandchildren, Shawn Baravetto (Rachel McBee) and Brittany (Benett) Mack; 3 great-grandchildren, Raven Baravetto, and Benny and Briella Mack; sisters-in-law, Helen Zahnle (Jim Hayes) and Marteen Kuczala; many nieces and nephews whom he was very close to; a special niece, Karen Johnson; he also leaves many friends from his church and Legion families.
