



## Nancy L. Sundholm

January 26, 1952 - March 15, 2024

Nancy L. Sundholm, 72, of Felch, passed away with her loving husband by her side on Friday, March 15, 2024 at the Iron County Medical Care Facility in Crystal Falls.

Nancy was born January 26, 1952 in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Louis and Laura (Morse) Siegler. She graduated from Felch High School in 1970 and was a lifelong resident of the area.
