Nicholas "Nicky" L. Amundson, 40, of Plymouth, Wisconsin, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, August 20, 2025.

He was born on January 24, 1985, in Appleton, Wisconsin, the beloved son of Howard Amundson and Patricia "Trisha" Powell.

Nick graduated from Kingsford High School in 2003 and went on to build a dedicated career in the foundry industry. 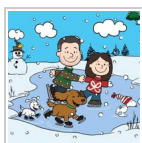

“ I met Nick when he was about 10 or 11—over time, we grew close, and I'll always remember him calling me "Sis" and that unforgettable laugh.

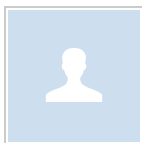
