Nick was born on May 15, 1927 in Crystal Falls, MI, son of the late Feruccio and Angelina (DeFransico) Muraro. Nick was raised in Crystal Falls and Loretto and was a graduate of Vulcan High School. After graduating, Nick enlisted into the United States Army and served during WWII until being honorably discharged on November 18, 1945. Following his discharge from the Army, he went back to school and went on to earn his degree from Northern Michigan University. He married Carol Hayward on July 2, 1960 at First Presbyterian Church. Nick began his working career at General Controls in Kingsford. He then served Dickinson County as a social worker for the Department of Social Services retiring as the Director in 1986. Following his retirement, he worked for Smeester Trucking for several years. Nick was an avid golfer and a member of Pine Grove Country Club. He was also a member of the Norway Moose Lodge. He especially loved going to camp Blackhawk, playing cards and his role as camp cook.

He is survived by his wife, Carol; his brother, Michael (Ann Marie) Muraro of Norway; his sisters, Betty Stachowitz of Niagara and Rosalie (Louis) Dallapiazza of Norway; sister in law, Rose Marie Muraro of Norway. Numerous nieces and nephews.
