BREITUNG TOWNSHIP - Norbert "Bing" Emond, 79, of N3905 Pine Mountain Road, Breitung Township, died, Saturday, March 15, 2008 at ManorCare Health Services in Kingsford.

Bing was born on May 19, 1928, son of the late Charles Raymond and Ethel (Gomber) Emond and has been a lifelong resident of this area. He served with the United States Army during World War II.

Bing married the former Lucille M. LeDocq on June 23, 1949, at American Martyrs Church in Kingsford. They owned and operated the Twin Pines Lumber Company from 1963 until his retirement in 1988. Bing was very active with the Iron Mountain-Kingsford Community Federal Credit Union. He has served on the board including the positions of secretary and chairman since 1961. Bing was also a member the Golden K.
