Noreen F. Gussert, age 85, of Kingsford passed away on Wednesday, April 3, 2019 at St. Vincent Hospital in Green Bay, WI.

Noreen was born on January 16, 1934 in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Dominic ("Patty") and Hilma (Anderson) Flaminio. She has been a lifelong resident of this area and was a 1952 graduate of Iron Mountain High School. Noreen married John (Chuck) Gussert on July 11, 1959 at American Martyrs in Kingsford. Chuck preceded her in death in 2004.

As a young woman she worked for WMIQ radio station and then for many years at Bertrand Insurance. Most recently she worked in the office for Simone Insurance Agency. Noreen was an active member of American Martyrs Church. She was also an avid member of the Paisano Club. She was named "Outstanding Paisano of the year" in 1986, and had been awarded the title, "Paisano Queen of the Italian Fest" in 2015.

Noreen was preceded in death by her daughter, Allison Graham; three brothers, Donald, Kenneth and Larry Flaminio, and two sisters, Jean Paoli and Geraldine "Sis" Perucco.
