



## Ole Lundin

February 21, 1923 - January 11, 2013

Ole G. Lundin, 89, of Iron Mountain, died Friday, Jan. 11, 2013, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital.

He was born Feb. 21, 1923, in Stambaugh, son of the late Ole and Theckla (Westerlund) Lundin. He graduated from Stambaugh High School in 1940 and later from Michigan State University with a master's degree in education administration.

He was a veteran of World War II and served as school administrator with the Department of Defense following the war. While in that position, he traveled extensively around the world to places including Spain, Germany, Newfoundland, and Iceland. Ole married Carol (Premo) Wickman in September 1991.
