August 17, 1918 - July 18, 2016

Olive Hinkley, 97, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Monday, July 18, 2016 at Dickinson County Healthcare System.

She was born August 17, 1918 in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Frank and Anna Maria (Parlanti) Palluconi. Olive graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1936 and was a lifelong resident of the area. She married Robert Hinkley on August 9, 1941 at Immaculate Conception Church in Iron Mountain. He preceded her in death on January 22, 1995.

Before her marriage, Olive worked for the Dickinson County Probate Court in Iron Mountain. After her marriage she left the Court to bear and raise her five children. In 1967, she and her husband bought the Hollywood Supper Club , where she put her considerable cooking skills to good use as the head chef. In 1969, after two very successful years they sold the Supper Club and Olive went to work for the Social Services Department in Iron Mountain where she spent ten years as a Social Worker.

When she wasn't working and tending to her five children she spent time painting, exhibiting her work in many shows in the local area. Olive was also known for her baking, especially at Xmas, when she made up to 28 different kinds of cookies and delivered them to fortunate friends and family.

Olive is survived by five children, Ann (John) Noble of Chapel Hill, NC, Richard "Rick" (Lynda) Hinkley of Iron Mountain, Gerard "Gerry " (Marge) Hinkley of Gainesville, GA, Steve (Diana) Hinkley of Clearwater, FL and Elizabeth "Beth" Hinkley of Appleton, WI; grandchildren, Shell (Brent) Fischer of Winchester, VA, Laura Noble (Josh Kalish) of Chapel Hill, NC, Cris Hinkley and Lauren Hinkley of Atlanta, GA and Amelia Fridley of Seminole, FL; great grandchildren, Emma Kalish, Graham Kalish and Mia Kalish of Chapel Hill, NC and Aurora Fridley of Seminole, FL.
