September 11, 1950 - January 21, 2024

Patricia Kay Gill, 73, of Iron Mountain, MI, passed away Sunday, January 21, 2024, at Maryhill Manor in Niagara surrounded by family.

Patti was born September 11, 1950, in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Anthony and Louise (Orella) Fontecchio. She graduated from Iron Mountain High School, Class of 1968, and attended Bay de Noc Community College. Patti married Jeffrey Gill on October 17, 1970, at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Iron Mountain, and she worked as an LPN in Dr. Batti's office for over 30 years before retiring in 2013.

In addition to her parents, she is preceded in death by a brother-in-law, Lewis Leslie, and her father and mother-in-law, Robert and Catherine Gill.
