Patrick Leslie Randall,

46, of Quinnesec MI passed away peacefully at his home February 5, 2015 surrounded by close friends and family. He was preceded in death by his father Irving "Bud" Randall, step-father Victor Gauthier and mother Monica (Ilenda) Randall Gauthier.

Born November 30, 1968, in Ann Arbor, Patrick served four years as a Navy Corpsman after graduating from Kingsford High School in 1987.
