Paul L. "Swede" Carlson, 85, of Iron Mountain passed away peacefully on Tuesday, Nov. 1, 2022, at Marshfield Medical Center Dickinson.

He was born in Iron Mountain on Jan. 26, 1937 to the late John and Ruth (Pettersson) Carlson. Swede graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1955. Known to be a jack of all trades, he was a great addition to several companies in his early years but may be remembered best for his work with Eagle Tool and Tousignant Drywall, from which he retired in 1999.
