Paul E. Larson, 91, passed away Saturday, March 12, 2022, at Dickinson County Healthcare System in Iron Mountain.

Paul was born August 14, 1930, in Iron Mountain, the son of Victor and Mayme (Soderquist) Larson. After graduating from Iron Mountain High School in 1948, he served in the United States Marine Corp. during the Korean War, and on August 13, 1955, he married Ruth Peterson. A lifelong resident of the area, Paul worked as a circulation manager for the Daily News in Iron Mountain, and later, as a CPA for Fleury Singler. He was a member of the First Covenant Church where he was very active, serving various positions and teaching Sunday school for over 50 years. He also enjoyed hunting, fishing, golfing and traveling.

Paul is survived by his wife, Ruth; three children, Susan (Carl) Johnson of Chicago, IL, Diane (Michael) Doster of Chesterfield, MO, and Thomas (Shirl) Larson of Spread Eagle, WI and Florida; 6 grandchildren; and 7 great-grandchildren.

He is preceded in death by three brothers, Marvin, Robert and John Larson.

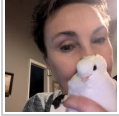
