RED WING, Minn. - Paul M. Nelson, 60, of Red Wing, passed away on Thursday, Jan. 7, 2010, at St. Mary's Hospital in Rochester, Minn.

Paul was born on Dec. 26, 1949, in Columbus, Ohio, the son of Paul B. and Charlotte A. (Martinson) Nelson. He graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1968 and went on to Northern Michigan University where he obtained a bachelor of science degree in social work.

Paul worked in the health care industry for many years, primarily in Fairbault, Minn., where he was employed at different state-run group homes for mentally challenged individuals. He was an avid Green Bay Packer fan, and he enjoyed fishing and listening to music, especially country songs.

Paul is survived by his parents, Paul and Charlotte Nelson of Iron Mountain; three brothers, Don (Pamela) Nelson of Iron Mountain, Dean Nelson of Shalimar, Fla. and Daryl (Sonja) Nelson of Iron Mountain; and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by a brother, David Nelson in 1978.

Visitation will be Tuesday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at Our Saviour's Lutheran Church in Iron Mountain.

Funeral services will follow Tuesday at 1 p.m. at the church. Rev. Stephen Cowen will officiate.

Burial will be in Evergreen Memorial Cemetery in Crystal Falls in the spring.
