Paula Iverson, of Kingsford, passed away on Thursday, July 8, 2010, at St. Mary's Hospital in Green Bay.

She was born on May 10, 1958, in Duluth, Minn., the daughter of the late Frank and Marion (Cooler) Slowinski. She graduated from Denfeld High School in Duluth in 1976. She married Lee Iverson on July 12, 1980, in Duluth. The couple moved to Green Bay where they lived until 1986, when they moved to Kingsford.

In 1986, Paula and Lee bought United Sign in Kingsford, now known as United Graphic Sign Co., where she worked as a bookkeeper.

Paula was an active member of American Martyrs Catholic Church and its church guild. She was also and member of the Knights of Columbus Women's Auxiliary and a former member of the Jaycees. Paula enjoyed cooking, flowers, and gardening. She was very family-oriented and was always there for her family.
