Pearl Ida Scott, 93, of Kingsford, died Sun. Sept. 23, 2012 at Freeman Nursing and Rehabilitation Community. She was born on Oct. 29, 1918 in Chicago, the daughter of the late Louis and Hannah Goetzke Hermann.

Pearl graduated from Harper High School in Chicago. Pearl was a secretary for Lions International in Oak Brook, IL for many years.
