Pedro P. Fonseca, 82, of Pembine, WI, formerly of Milwaukee, died Sun. Sept. 19, 2010 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital. He was born in Havana, Cuba on June 29, 1928, the son of the late Eugenia Perez Rodriguez and Santiago Fonseca Sanches.
