Peggy Marie Oman, 43, of Felch, died Sunday, May 23, 2010 at the Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital after a seven year battle with breast cancer.

She was born September 10, 1966 in Belvidere, Il, daughter of Carl Wille and Judy Gaskins. Peggy moved to this area with her parents in 1978. She graduated from North Dickinson High School in 1984. On August 18, 1990, she married Steve Oman at the Zion Lutheran Church in Metropolitan.
