



Ramona M. Dupuis

July 8, 1925 - October 31, 2015

Ramona M. Dupuis, 90, of Breitung Township passed away Saturday, October 31, 2015 at her home surrounded by her children and her beloved pet.

Ramona was born Hannelore Lina Anna Reichenberger in Berlin, Germany on July 8, 1925 to the late Johannes and Eleanore (Scholz) Reichenberger. As a youth she studied singing, especially opera, along with piano and dance. She met her husband, Elwyn Isaac Dupuis, on a blind date during WWII in Germany. In 1953, she arrived in Michigan and married on May 8. They raised 9 children together in a large refurbished schoolhouse on Bass Lake Road where she was a devoted mother and homemaker. She loved painting, knitting, crocheting, writing, and recalling memories for anyone who would listen. During the 1970s, Ramona was known locally as the “love and peace girl” on talk radio. Ramona always had a passion for the less fortunate, volunteering for years at a youth center for troubled teens and donating to numerous charities. She had a strong faith in Jesus and instilled His love in her children. After their children were raised, she continued to reside at home with her pets.

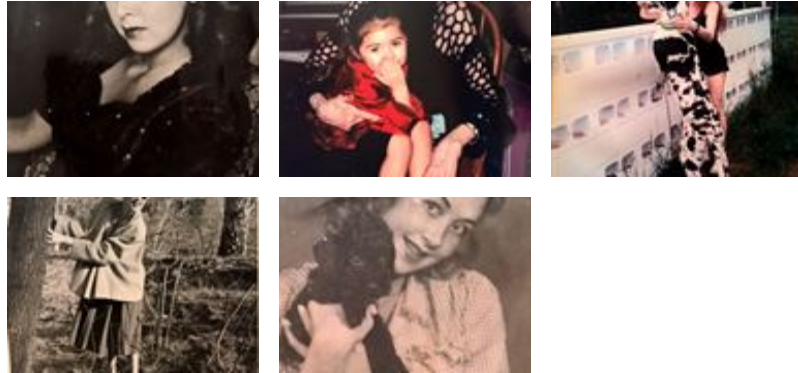
