IRON MOUNTAIN - Randy J. Larson, 61, of Iron Mountain, died Wednesday, Oct. 22, 2008, at his home.

He was born on Aug. 14, 1947, son of the late Kenneth and Kathleen (Schuirmann) Larson. He attended Kingsford High School graduating in 1965.

He enlisted in the United States Army on Dec. 4, 1967, and was sent to Vietnam. While there, Randy distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous actions for which he received the honor of the Vietnam Gallantry Cross, the Silver Star and the Purple Heart for gallantry in action involving close combat with the Vietnamese.

On May 12, 1969, while serving as a scout with the 2nd Battalion, 47th Infantry his element came under intense fire from well entrenched positions, his armored personnel carrier led a flanking movement to the enemy's position. Despite the heavy volume of rocket propelled grenade fire, he drove his vehicle into one of the bunkers, destroying it. His vehicle then sustained a direct hit, and he was wounded in the leg. Ignoring his pain, he continued to fight until relief arrived.

From the office of the President under the provisions of the Act of Congress it was stated that Specialist Larson's extraordinary heroism in close combat with

an armed hostile force is in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, the 9th Infantry Division and the United States Army. He was honorably discharged on Dec. 1, 1973.

He married Denise Petschar in Iron Mountain in 1975 at the home of his brother in-law and sister in-law, Dean and Patti Petschar.

Randy worked for Bacco Construction for nine years. He then went to work with the United States Post Office as a clerk for more than 30 years, retiring on Aug. 1, 2008.

He was a lifelong resident of the area. He loved fast cars and motorcycles. Randy was the one in the family that everyone went to with any kind of a fix-it project; car repair, gardening, remodeling, oil painting or electronics, Randy could do it all. He went about his way always with a smile and an artist's touch. He was a kind, gentle, multi-talented man who will be greatly missed by all whose lives he touched. We're changed now, not because he left us, but because he touched us.

Randy is survived by his loving wife, Denise; sons, Jess (Taryn) Larson of Clawson, Mich., Nick (Fiance, Naomi) Larson of Green Bay, Wis., Brian (Corrine) Pinks of Chandler, Ariz. and Sune Laugeson of Denmark; grandchildren, Brody Larson, Abby Vanderwege, and Teagan, Elizabeth and Owen Petschar; two brothers, Rick (Joanne) Larson and Kenny Larson, both of Beloit, Wis.; four sisters, Linda Meade of Beloit, Marlene (Tom) Leinen of St. Joseph, Mo., Christine (Mike) Rousseau of Beloit, and Laura (Amos) Hummel of Beloit; sisters-in-law and brothers-in-law, Dana (Todd) Colenso, Dean (Patti) Petschar, Darla (John) Olson, Lynn (Buck) Gussert, Darren (Sherri) Petschar; many nieces, nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews; special friends, Don (Terry) Summers and Pat (Betty) LaVigne; and his dog, Cinder.

He was preceded in death by a sister, Jody Rose.

Visitation will be Saturday from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Erickson-Rochon & Nash Funeral Home.

The funeral service will follow Saturday at 1 p.m. at the funeral home. Rev. Michael March will officiate.

Burial will be in Cemetery Park in Iron Mountain.
