QUINNESEC - Reval Holt, 90, of Quinnesec, died Wednesday, March 3, 2010, at Maryhill Manor in Niagara.

She was born on June 1, 1919 in Norma, Tenn., the daughter of the late Harrison and Edna (Byrd) Posey. Reval worked as a substitute teacher in Tennessee before moving to Detroit. She also worked at Uniroyal Tire Co. as a secretary.

While working at Uniroyal, she met her future husband, Charles Robert "Bob" Holt. They were married on Jan. 29, 1949, in Indiana. The couple moved their family to Kingsford in 1975. Bob preceded her in death in 1986.

Reval was a member of Quinnesec United Methodist Church and an active member of the church woman's group. She was also a member of the local women's extension group. Reval enjoyed crocheting, quilting, sewing, crafting and listening to music.
