



Richard "Dick" McGuire

July 15, 1952 - December 13, 2015

Richard J. "Dick" McGuire, 63, of Foster City, died Sunday morning after fighting a courageous battle with early onset Alzheimer's Disease.

Dick was born on July 15, 1952 in Escanaba, the son of the late Chester and Thelma (Erickson) McGuire. He graduated from Bark River High School in 1971. Dick served in the U.S. National Guard. He was a heavy equipment operator for M.J. Electric for over thirty-five years. He was an excellent mechanic and could fix almost anything. Dick was a math genius, a skill he used when playing cards. He thoroughly enjoyed music and singing, and was a great whistler. He also loved his Harley Davidson Motorcycle. Dick was well known for his quick witted sense of humor and likeable personality. Most importantly, Dick enjoyed spending time with family; especially his grandchildren. He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church.
