NIAGARA, Wis. - Richard A. "Dick" Nelson, 78, of Niagara, died Friday, Sept. 18, 2009, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain.

He was born on Nov. 4, 1930, in Iron Mountain, the son of the late Enoch and Elin (Johnson) Nelson.

Dick graduated from Niagara High School. He worked as a millwright at the Niagara Paper Mill for 44 years, retiring in 1992.

He married Mary Jane Lough on Dec. 6, 1951, in Norway. The couple enjoyed 57 years of marriage.
