Richard "Dick" Vick, 75, of East Kingsford, passed away on Friday, December 26, 2014 at Dickinson County Hospital. Dick was born on February 24, 1939 in Kingsford, son of the late William and Lillian (Gribben) Vick and has been a lifelong resident of this area. He graduated from Kingsford High School with the class of 1957. Dick enlisted into the United States Navy in 1958 and was stationed in Rhode Island aboard the USS Essex as a Flight Mechanic. He was honorably discharged in 1962. Dick married Carol Cerasoli on April 24, 1965 at First Presbyterian Church in Kingsford. He worked as a Heavy Equipment Mechanic for Hanna mining for seventeen years until the mine closed.
