Rick J. Gendron, 74, of Upper Pine Creek, passed away on Monday, April 14, 2025 at Froedtert Hospital in Milwaukee, WI.

He was born May 21, 1950 in Iron Mountain, son of the late Frank and Dean Doris (Hewitt) Gendron. Rick graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1968 and went on to attend Northern Michigan University where he graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Industrial Arts.
