Robert Earl "Bobby" Anderson, 53, of Kingsford, died Monday, July 25, 2016 at the Clement J. Zablocki VA Medical Center in Milwaukee. He was born on July 4, 1963 in Iron Mountain, the son of the late Robert Elmer and Jean (Alexander) Anderson.

Bobby graduated from Kingsford High School in 1982 and served in the United States Marine Corps from 1982-1987. He transported explosives, while being stationed in Okinawa, Japan. Bobby worked for Superior Steel. He also worked and spent time at the Woodward Bar, where he made many special lifelong friends.

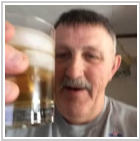
