Robert W. "Bob" Beaster, 73, of Aurora, passed away on Monday, November 4, 2013 at the Oscar G. Johnson V.A. Medical Center in Iron Mountain.

He was born May 4, 1940 in Phelps, WI, son of the late Anthony and Clara (Bradley) Beaster. Bob attended the Kingsford Schools and was a lifelong resident of the area.
