March 6, 1928 - March 31, 2011

Robert M. "Bobby" Charlevoix, 83, of Wakefield, died Thursday, March 31, 2011, at Aspirus Hospital in Wausau, Wis.

He was born on March 6, 1928, in Detroit, son of the late Stephen and Margaret (Murray) Charlevoix. Robert was a veteran of the United States Navy and served in the Pacific Theater of Operations from 1945-49.

He married the former LeeAnn Bay on June 27, 1958, in Eagle River, Wis. and she preceded him in death on Oct. 1, 1976. Robert retired from the White Pine Mine where he worked as a welder for many years. He was a member of the Wakefield Veterans of Foreign Wars and enjoyed hunting, spending time at camp and was a talented wood carver.

He is survived by his son, Matthew Charlevoix of Colorado; his daughter, Jill Charlevoix of Ironwood; grandsons, Benjamin and Patrick Kapugia of Bessemer; a brother, Stephen (Marilyn) Charlevoix of Foster City; brother-in-law, Patrick Milligan and sister-in-law, Alice Charlevoix.
