KINGSFORD - Robert "Bobby" Faas, 38, of Kingsford, died Monday, Dec. 22, 2008, at the Clement J. Zablocki VA Medical Center in Milwaukee.

He was born May 10, 1970, in Rockville, N.Y. Upon graduating from high school, Bobby enlisted in the United States Navy on Aug. 2, 1989, serving with the Navy during Operation Desert Storm. He was honorably discharged on July 1, 1994. While in the Navy, Bobby graduated from the mechanics program and had worked in that industry the rest of his days.
