



## Robert Piasini

February 3, 1916 - February 3, 2011

Robert "Muzzy" Piasini, 95, of Channing, died Thursday, Feb. 3, 2011, at the Iron County Medical Care Facility in Crystal Falls.

He was born May 20, 1915, in Channing, son of the late Emil and Mary Piasini. Muzzy was a lifelong resident of Channing and graduated from Channing High School in 1935. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II.

He married Genevieve Hinkley on Sept. 1, 1951, in Milwaukee. She preceded him in death on Jan. 27, 1992.

Muzzy owned and operated the Channing garage with his partner, Leonard "Wimpy" Lindeman, for many years before retiring. He was a member of St. Rose Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus, and the American Legion Post 168.

He was preceded in death by one brother, George Piasini and a brother-in-law, Doug Rasmussen.

He is survived by five children, Linda (Mike) Piasini Klis of Muskego, Wis., Larry (Nannette) Piasini of West Allis, Wis., Brian Piasini of Channing, Kenny Piasini of Channing, and David (Kathy) Piasini of Channing; one sister, Mary Rasmussen of Channing; four grandchildren, Phillip and Cassandra Piasini,

and Jennifer, and Kristine Piasini.

Visitation will be on Tuesday, Feb, 8, from 10 a.m. until 12 noon at St. Rose Church in Channing.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday at 12 noon at the church. Fr. Raymond Valerio will offer the Mass of Christian Burial.

Burial will be in the Channing Cemetery in the spring with full military rites.
