Robert "Bob" Allen Sanicki, 79, of Niagara, WI, passed away on Friday, May 22, 2026, at St. Vincent Hospital in Green Bay, WI, with his family by his side.

Bob was born in Norway, MI, on March 23, 1947, to the late Walter and Constance (DuFresne) Sanicki. He graduated from Niagara High School in 1965. Two years later he enlisted with the U.S. Navy where Bob served for four years, completing stints in Morocco and Italy, before being honorably discharged on February 1, 1971. Bob started working for ISP Minerals in Pembine, WI, in 1971, working there for over 30 years prior to his retirement.
