Robert "Bob" J. Tedeschi, 58 of Iron Mountain, passed away at his home on Monday, February 29, 2016 following a brief illness. Bob was born on February 14, 1958 in Iron Mountain, son of the late Rudolph and Carole (Possi) Tedeschi. He attended school in Iron Mountain, graduating from Iron Mountain High School in 1976. Following graduation, Bob founded Tedeschi Auto Body. In 1981 he enlisted in the United States Air Force, serving 5 years as an Avionics Tech before an honorable discharge in 1986. Upon returning home, he worked 21 years for Edward's Automotive before owning and operating General Paint and Collision in Kingsford. For the past 2 years, Bob worked as an insurance adjuster for Michigan Appraisal Company.

In his free time Bob loved home building and woodworking; he was a true perfectionist. No matter the time of year he was always busy with a project. He spent much of his time building his various homes, including the construction of a beautiful log home on Spring Lake and his new home on Blaine street. He was an excellent carpenter who took great pride in his work. He also loved to play guitar.
