Roberta M. "Bobbi" Campbell, 74, of Aurora, died Sun. October 9, 2016 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital. She was born on June 19, 1942 in Norway, the daughter of the late Emil and Wilna (Raboin) DeClark.

Roberta graduated from Niagara High School in 1960. She went to beauty school and worked as a beautician at Renee's Beauty Shop.
