Roger William Baravetto, 90, of Kingsford, MI, passed away on Wednesday, May 24, 2023, at his home.

Roger was born in Iron Mountain on Aug. 9, 1932, son of the late James & Rose (Andrini) Baravetto. He graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1951 and was a lifelong resident of the area. Roger married Patricia VanPembroke on Sept. 27, 1952 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Aurora, WI. He served four years in the U.S. Navy and was honorably discharged in 1956. Roger was employed at Michigan Bell Phone Co. for over 30 years, retiring in 1994.
