Ronald Dean Henry, 78 of Niagara, passed away on Tuesday, August 27, 2013 at his home, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born on September 28, 1934 in Iron Mountain, son of the late Wesley and Gertrude (Truinstra) Henry. He married Jacqueline Abraham on September 26, 1959 in Marinette, WI. Ron served in the United States Army from 1954 to 1956 during the Korean War. After being honorably discharged from the Army he worked for Wisconsin Public Service as a lineman until his retirement in 1997. A former resident of Marinette, he and Jackie built a log home in Niagara in 2000 and they have enjoyed their retirement on the lake there since.

Ron is survived by his loving wife, Jackie; 4 sons and 10 grandchildren, Bjorn (Stacy) Henrickson of Manitowoc and their children Brooke, Justin, Olivia, Landon, and Luke; Eric (Karen) Henry of Albany, WI and their children Zachary, Kaitlynn, and Rylan; Mark (Lisa) Henry of Woodruff, WI and their children Brennan and Seth; and Mike Henry of Green Bay, WI.
