



## Rosemary Sullivan

January 7, 1924 - January 7, 2010

QUINNESEC - Rosemary E. Sullivan, 86, formerly of 3775 Menominee Ave. in Quinnesec, died Thursday, Jan. 7, 2010, at the Hyland Nursing Home.

She was born Feb. 8, 1923, in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late John and Ella (Massie) Sullivan. She was a lifelong resident of this area, spending most of her life in Quinnesec. Rosemary graduated from the Quinnesec High School in 1940 and from nursing school, where she earned her L.P.N. degree. She had worked at Pinecrest Nursing Home and at Hyland Nursing Home.

She was a member of the Daughters of Isabella, the Women's Catholic Order of Forresters, and a former member of St. Mary Church in Quinnesec.

She is survived by two nieces and five nephews, and many great-nieces and great-nephews.

She was preceded in death by three sisters, Mary Baughman, Marguerite Sullivan, and Catherine Sullivan; two brothers, Donald and Clement Sullivan, and two sisters-in-law, Marie Sullivan and Dorothy Sullivan.
