Rudolph "Rudy" K. Makoutz, 98, of Aurora, passed away Saturday, Nov. 6, 2010, at Hyland Nursing Home in Iron Mountain.

He was born on Jan. 6, 1912, on the Makoutz Family Farm in Aurora, son of the late Lorenz and Frances (Jorger) Makoutz. He attended school in Kingsford, graduating from Kingsford High School.

Upon graduating he started work with the Great Northern Railroad Co., eventually retiring as an engineer. He was a quiet, faithful, hardworking man who believed in a strong work ethic.

Rudy loved the outdoors and hunting. He spent much of his life as a volunteer for the Catholic church.
